In 2014, the IRC evolved into the International Chapter with Juana Poulisis, MD, of Argentina as its first Chapter President. Our efforts focused on global outreach, support, training and development.

In 2018, the iaedp™ International Chapter was reorganized upder its new President Rosanna Mauro de Maya, MS, RD of Costa Rica with iaedp™ Director of International Affairs Blanche A. 


